

## **Juniper Creek Fact Sheet**

### **Mileage One-Way**

(Remember, "river left" is the left side of the river headed downstream.)

- 0.0 Juniper Springs launch (N29.18441 W81.71164)
- 3.9 Old dock – not much left, you have to look carefully to find it. (N29.20604 W81.68484)
- 5.0 Creek starts to widen and open up (N29.21771 W81.67986)
- 5.4 "The Rapids", short stretch of shallow water over spring (N29.22239 W81.67879)
- 6.7 To left, Sweetwater Spring run enters (N29.21823 W81.65932)
- 6.8 Pilings from old bridge (N29.21385 W81.65495)
- 7.2 Pass under SR 19 bridge, take-out on river right (N29.21335 W81.65469)

From the east: From the intersection of State Rd 40 and State Rd 19 go west 4.6 miles to the campground entrance on your right. Large sign on your left.

From the west: From the intersection of State Rd 40 and State Rd 314 in Nubys Corner go east on SR 40 for 16.8 miles to recreation area entrance on your left. Large sign on your right.

SR 19, Astor, FL 32102 352-625-2808

From the intersection of State Rd 40 and State Rd 19, go north on SR 19 for 3.5 miles. Entrance is on your right, just before the bridge.
