

Silver River Fact Sheet (updated 06/2016)

In chart below "boat ramp" means a constructed ramp, usually concrete or metal. "Launch" indicates a hand launch area i.e., a canoe/kayak put-in.

Also, because of the limited number of road bridges across the Suwannee, when setting up your own shuttle (or paying for a commercial outfitter) you will usually be better off paddling between boat ramps that sit on the same side of the river. The SRWMD map poster of boat ramps will help you a great deal with this.

These are not all the access points on the Suwannee River, but it includes most of the public and SRWT "Hub" access points. We have also excluded some of the more expensive private resorts and places where we feel access is particularly difficult (such as requiring 4WD, etc). Of particular note is the PCA/Swift Creek launch. Call a local outfitter about the PCA/Swift Creek launch before attempting to use it.

Unlike most of our mileage charts where we use ACTUAL PADDLE MILES averaged from multiple trips, in order for our info to mesh with other published info about the Suwannee here we are using RIVER MILES - as if we paddled exactly down the middle of the river. We suggest you add 10-15% to the mileages to reflect crossing from side to side, exploring side streams, and finding sand banks for swimming and/or camping.

We have tried to be as accurate as possible, but particularly with constant road name changes, development, and land ownership changes it is a struggle to keep up. It is presented "as is" in an effort to help, but with no guarantee.

The Anderson Landing ramp is located in the town of Suwannee on CR 349. It's 0.5 miles paddle via Demory Creek to the Suwannee River. Bill's Fish Camp with camping is in the same location.
